Motion: To return \$320,000 from Education A.1.a. (Neighborhood learning center) back to Housing A.1. (development of housing on specific sites).

# **Grievance Considered on Sidewalk Lighting**

A grievance was filed with the PPERRIA Executive Committee on the neighborhood sidewalk lighting plan. Mr. Steve Ficker who lives on the 1800 block of Franklin Avenue and Ms. Kay Teberg who lives on Barton Avenue filed the grievance. The Executive Committee at its meeting on December 14, 1998 considered it.

The grievance said that the entire sidewalk lighting process was invalid and requested that the process of approving the project be re-commenced from the beginning. The reasons for the grievance and the responses heard were:

The grievance failed to get any audible "aye" votes at the PPERRIA Executive Committee meeting with all members apparently voting "no." The decision to not sustain the grievance can be appealed to NRP. Mr. Ficker and Ms. Teberg indicated that they would appeal.

#### Fire & Ice Festival Coordinator Needed

Luxton Park Council seeks an individual(s) to coordinate the 1999 Fire & Ice Festival at Luxton Park. Volunteers will oversee various aspects of the festival, from obtaining permits to entertainment and food. # **PPERRIA NRP Fund Reallocation Planned**

PPERRIA and the Prospect Park East River Road neighborhood will be reallocating \$26,051 in Neighborhood Revitalization Plan (NRP) funds. A reallocation proposal meeting in January will allow interested parties to present proposals and take questions from the audience. No vote will be taken at the meeting. Based on information from this meeting, the Reallocation Committee will then develop a plan proposal for use of these funds. The Reallocation Committee is composed of representatives from all areas of the neighborhood and all NRP committees. This plan will be presented to a joint meeting of PPERRIA and the neighborhood in January.

To make a presentation at the Reallocation Proposal meeting, you must submit a completed proposal form. Forms can be picked up at Pratt, Luxton, or Tower Grocery, and must be delivered to the PPERRIA mailbox in the Pratt Community Center office on or before Friday, January 8. Copies of the NRP plan may be obtained by calling Reallocation Committee co-chair Alison Savin at 378-9751. The Reallocation Proposal meeting is scheduled for 7:00 PM on Wednesday, January 13, in Room A at Luxton Park. Presenters will have a limited time to speak and take questions; the time allotted will depend on the number of presenters wishing to speak. The Reallocation Plan will be presented for a neighborhood vote at the January 25, 1999 PPERRIA meeting. We invite all residents of the neighborhood, as well as PPERRIA members, to attend to vote on the proposed plan.

Grievance:	Response:
The NRP action plan included two "options." The first listed was for an increase in wattage of existing lights and the addition of several additional lights. The second "option" was for the sidewalk lighting. The neighborhood was not given the chance to choose between the two options.	The two "options" in the NRP Plan were not either by the Plan?s own words or by common understanding meant to be alternatives of which only one was to be chosen by the neighborhood. In fact, both the additional lighting and the sidewalk lighting are being implemented. The fact that work started first on the sidewalk lighting option isn?t affected by lack of simultaneous action on a separate option.
The action at the June, 1997, PPERRIA meeting to proceed with the sidewalk lighting without voting on the two options and without action on the first option was a change in the NRP Action plan that had to be approved at a neighborhood meeting.	The NRP action plan has never been changed either explicitly or implicitly. The action at the June 1997, meeting was a "release of funds" for the sidewalk project not a change in the plan by adopting sidewalk lighting to the exclusion of additional street lighting.

## Prospect Park East River Road Neighborhood Calendar

The vote at the June 1997, meeting was not widely promoted in advance. As a result, the required neighborhood support of the project that is required by NRP does not exist.	The vote took place at the regular monthly meeting. The meeting and the issue of whether to release funds were publicized by neighborhood signs, advertisements in Neighborhood newspapers, and in the PPERRIA newsletter.
The approval vote in June 1997 was restricted to PPERRIA members. Non-members should have been allowed to vote in order for it to be required broad neighborhood support.	PPERRIA is only the "fiscal agent" managing the NRP money. The NRP Steering Committee that existed through the neighborhood adoption of the NRP Action Plan was dissolved once the plan was approved. The original approval of the Action Plan was voted upon neighborhood wide. Since then, PPERRIA has followed the plan. There is no requirement for general neighborhood vote on every action of the "fiscal agent?s" administration.
