### **Motion for July**

MOTION: To release \$25,640.00 from Education C.1 of the neighborhood's NRP funds to Southeast Seniors, A Living at Home/Block Nurse Program

The project will help frail senior residents of Southeast Minneapolis stay living at home. Services include inhome nursing and home health aide care provided on a sliding fee scale, service coordination, volunteer visitors, and neighborhood blood pressure checks and health promotion. These services enable older adults who are facing declining health to remain longer in their own neighborhoods, safely, with maximized quality of life and with companionship and links to the community.

There are no competing projects for these funds at this time.

### University Avenue Corridor (John DeWitt)

What do the residents of Prospect Park want the University Avenue Corridor to look like 20 years from now? With growing development and redevelopment pressure, it's important that we have plans in place sooner rather than later. PPERRIA's Transportation and Land Use Planning Committee has begun a planning process involving our neighborhood, Hennepin County and the City of Minneapolis. The first meeting was held on July 16th and began defining the process and the outcomes. It is anticipated that the entire process will take about six months. The outcome may be incorporated into Minneapolis' Master Plan or could simply be a zoning overlay district. It's important to note that the planning process will be independent of any specific transit mode on University Avenue. If further funding is obtained, a set of development guidelines might be undertaken. Your attendance at these meetings is strongly encouraged as it represents your opportunity to weigh in on what your neighborhood will look like in the future. Watch for future meeting announcements. ## Wipe Out Graffiti

If you're concerned about the amount of graffiti you see in the neighborhood, you can take action. The sooner graffiti is reported and removed, the less likely it is to be repeated. If you see graffiti in progress, call 911 immediately. At any other time, report graffiti by phone to the Graffiti Hotline at 612-673-2090, online at <a href="https://www.ci.minneapolis.mn.us/graffiti">www.ci.minneapolis.mn.us/graffiti</a>, or by mail to Minneapolis Graffiti Enforcement, 3101 Niccollet Ave., Mpls 55404.

If you find graffiti on your property, you are responsible for removing it within 20 days. For information on removal techniques, contact the Clean City Coordinator at 612-673-2789. Additional concerns may be addressed through the Community Crime Prevention/SAFE office at 612-673-3015.

Graffiti on business property should also be reported to the Graffiti hotline. The business owner is responsible for removing it. The following list of phone number may be helpful in calling graffiti to the attention of businesses so they can remove it in a timely manner:
