

Neighborhoods 2020 is an opportunity to further develop and improve upon the City of Minneapolis' neighborhood based engagement structure. Neighborhood organizations are by the people, for the people. On May 17, 2019, the City Council passed the Neighborhoods 2020 framework and two staff directions supporting community engagement. City staff are directed to develop a workplan and timeline for adopting a Citywide community engagement policy. Staff are further directed to work with a consultant(s) to continue conversations with neighborhoods and the community on program guidelines and metrics for the Neighborhoods 2020 framework while continuing to ensure that racial equity remains at the core of the work.
