What is this forum for?

This forum is to host discussions, recommendations, questions and any other topic that may concern the residents of Prospect Park, Minneapolis. It is open to any and all who live in the Prospect Park neighborhood, and can be a way for neighbors to connect and foster ideas, involvement and action. It is not meant to replace the e-list, but rather give people more options to interact with neighbors, businesses, non-profits and government entities. E-democracy is a non profit that was created in Minneapolis, and now has forums to serve communities world-wide.

How to get started:

Head over to "http://forums.e-democracy.org/groups/mpls-prospectpark/" and click on "Sign In/Join" on the top right corner. You should be able to customize your account to your preferences--including how many emails you would like to get per day (the default is one email per post, but that can be changed!) To post you can either use your email or the website itself. Please also read all the rules and terms of use.
