## Learn about the Board Candidates Here


Join the PPA Board of Directors! Candidate Profile submission deadline extended to Wednesday, May 3

According to Earthday.org, the theme for this year's Earth Month is "Invest in Our Planet". This fits in so well with the PPA Environment Committee's "25% by '25" initiative that I knew I had to include an article in the newsletter. Prospect Park has beautiful old houses, but our 100-year-old homes come at a high price to the environment. Did you know that natural gas accounts for 41% of the CO2 emissions in Minneapolis?

Please invest in your home. It's not just the planet and your neighbors who will benefit. Your finances will, too.

#### No and Low Cost

- Get an energy audit - <u>Home Energy Squad | Center for Energy and Environment</u> (<u>mncee.org</u>) - free for most households. \* Note: If you have purchased your home since January of 2020, you can download an energy report on your home at: <u>Energy</u> <u>Disclosure | Center for Energy and Environment (mncee.org</u>)

- Seal doors and window frames. Put plastic wrap over windows in the winter. Insulate between joists in the basement.

- Plant a tree - in years to come, it will cool down your house naturally.

Upfront costs, but incredible Return on Investment:

- See <u>ROI for Home Energy Improvements: Part of our 25% by '25 Initiative -</u> <u>YouTube</u> for details on how long it takes to start earning money - Insulate and air seal your attic

- Insulate your walls. 1 in 5 houses in Prospect Park have little to no wall insulation.

Break even upgrades:

- Replacing your gas powered Hot Water Heater with an electric model
- Replacing your central AC unit with a Heat Pump or Mini Split.
