Prospect Park Association will hold a Community Meeting at 6:30pm on Monday, December 4th to discuss a Merger Exploratory Report.

Four neighborhood organizations, Prospect Park Association (PPA), Southeast Como Improvement Association (SECIA), Marcy-Holmes Neighborhood Association, and the Nicollet Island/East Bank Neighborhood Association received a \$20,000 grant from the City of Minneapolis to explore merging.

As part of the grant, Willow Consulting worked with three representatives from each of the four neighborhood organizations and created a Merger Exploratory Report.

A merger is one of the financial strategies PPA is exploring to ensure we can continue fulfilling our mission to serve Prospect Park despite the significant decrease in City of Minneapolis funding.

No decisions have been made yet. The board of each of the four neighborhood organizations is expected to decide by February whether or not they intend to merge. Neighborhood organizations that decide to merge will work with legal counsel to develop a Merger Plan Agreement including new governing documents such as articles of incorporation, mission, bylaws, and also a staffing plan, new organization name, and more. Read the Merger Exploratory Report for more on the timeline and process.

At PPA's meeting on December 4th they'll be a brief summary presentation of the Merger Exploratory Report followed by opportunities for community feedback.

The 25% by '25 results are in and 2022 was another great year!

25% by '25 is the Environment Committee's initiative to bring down residential



natural gas usage in our neighborhood by 25% by the end of 2025.

It can be a challenge to compare one year to another when looking at energy usage, given the fluctuations in weather. I've added the average temperature of the 6 coldest months to mitigate this. We also need to look at how we are doing against the city of Minneapolis as a whole. That's where we can really see our progress since 2019. While the overall city's usage increased by 2.5%, Prospect Park's decreased by 4.7%! Woo-hoo!

We eliminated 621 pounds (per building!) of CO2 from being produced in 2022! Let's keep it going and make 2023 an even better year!


