

The goal of '25% by '25' is to bring about a 25% reduction of residential natural gas usage in Prospect Park by the end of 2025 compared to 2020.

We will be having our annual celebration on Saturday, October 21st, from 10-12 in front of 118 Arthur Ave SE. (If it rains we will have it at the Luxton Park building.) Everyone is welcome! There will be music and treats and we will be sharing the progress we've made since 2019 through 2022.




